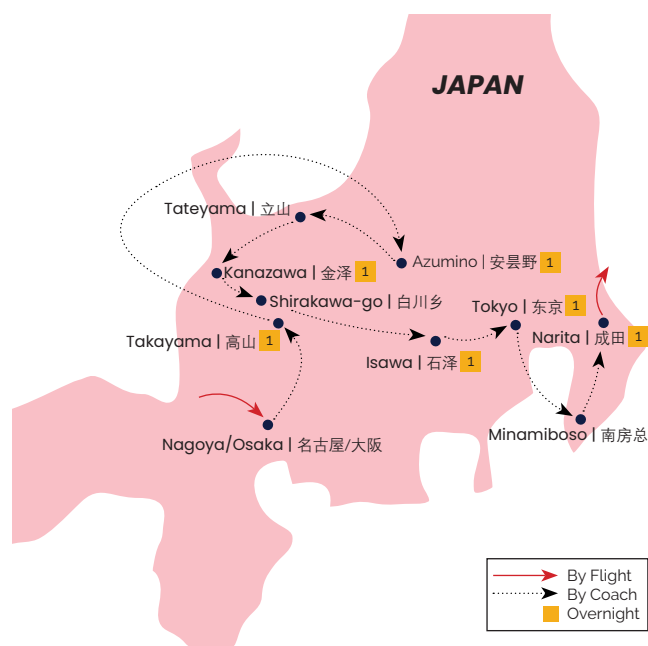

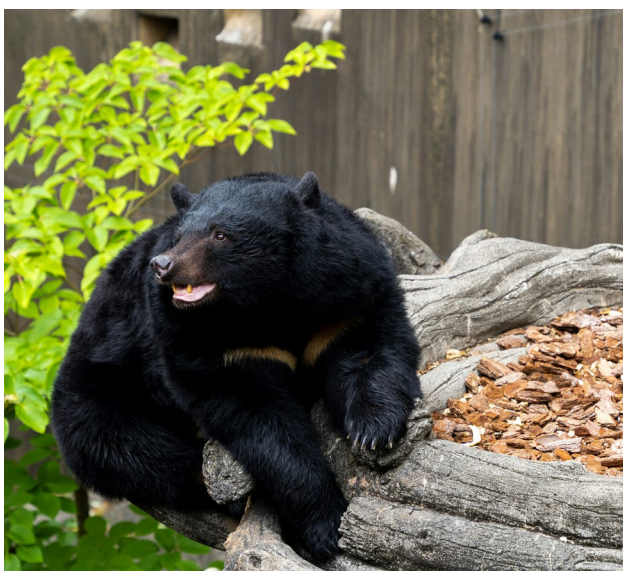

## SINGAPORE > NAGOYA/OSAKA

DAY 02

## NAGOYA/OSAKA - TAKAYAMA

*Meals on board | Japanese Set Lunch | Hotel Dinner*

- **Inuyama Castle** - Built in the 16th century, was among the tens of thousands of castles present at the time. The castle, one of the 12, has been designated as a National Treasure. A small hill overlooking the Kiso River.
- **Hida Takayama Mountains** - Small town located in the hollow of the mountain, Takayama, with its old wooden houses, craft shops and sake breweries, retains a charm of old times. Often compared to Kyoto, the city is a destination that opens the doors to the Japanese Alps. Therefore, it is called Takayama Old Street.

DAY 03

## TAKAYAMA - AZUMINO

*Breakfast | Topanyaki Lunch | Hotel Dinner*

- **Kamikochi** - The jewel of the Japan Alps, renowned for its stunning natural scenery. Situated in a 1,500-metre-high basin, it is home to the beautiful Azusa River and the iconic Kappa Bridge.
- **Okuhida Bear Ranch** - Is a place where you can observe bears up close. The pasture is dominated by Asiatic black bears, and there are more than 100 bears including brown bears.
- *\*Note: In the event Okuhida Bear Ranch is closed, it will be replaced by Kawaguchi Ropeway.*

DAY 04

## AZUMINO - TATEYAMA - KANAZAWA

*Breakfast | Tateyama Set Lunch | Kaiseki Set Dinner*

- A day of endless fun awaits you along the 37.2-kilometre route from Ogizawa to Tateyama Station. The Tateyama Kurobe Alpine Route, known as the Japanese Alps, lies within a protected Nature Reserve, where access is limited to designated transportation only.

1	Trolley Bus	A 16-minute Trolley Bus will take you from Ogizawa to Kurobe Dam.	1470 metres
	Walk <i>(Comfortable shoes needed)</i>	15-minute by foot from Kurobe Dam to Kurobeko, witnessing the awe-inspiring Lake Kurobe surrounded by the Alps. See 186m height Kurobe Dam with water.	1455 metres
2	Kurobe Cable Car	A 5-minute Kurobe Cable car will take you from Kurobeko ascending to Kurobedaira.	1828 metres
3	Tateyama Ropeways	From Kurobedaira, a 7-minute Tateyama Ropeway will ascend Daikanbo. From the cabin, you can see scenic snow-capped mountains surrounding Lake Kurobe.	2316 metres
4	Tateyama Tunnel Trolley Bus <i>(Gloves needed)</i>	From Daikanbo, a 10-minute electrical Tateyama Trolley Bus will take you to Murodo. At the peak of Tateyama, you can see snow between Apr-Jun, Oct-Nov <i>(subject to weather conditions)</i> .	2450 metres
5	Tateyama Highland Bus	From Murodo, a 50-minute Tateyama Highland Bus will take you to Bijodaira. See the famous Shomyo Waterfalls, the famous 18-metre snow corridor and the possible sea of clouds.	977 metres
6	Tateyama Cablecar	From Bijodaira, a 7-minute cable car descending to Tateyama Station.	475 metres

- *\*Note: In the event that any motor transport is undergoing annual maintenance and/or bad weather conditions, itinerary will be completed using a motor coach and there will be no refund of services. Wheelchairs not permitted on this trip.*

DAY 05

## KANAZAWA – SHIRAKAWA-GO – ISAWA

*Breakfast | Kamameshi Set Lunch | Hotel Dinner*

- **Kenroku-en Garden (Include Admission Fees)** – One of Japan’s top 3 gardens. The name refers to a renowned garden from China’s Song Dynasty that requires 6 attributes for perfection: seclusion, spaciousness, artificiality antiquity, abundant water and broad view.
- **Shirakawa-go Ogimachi Gassho Village** – This tranquil mountain village of 113 buildings was registered in 1995 as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Its architectural design is known as “gassho-zukuri”, and slopes at a steep angle of 60° for protection against heavy snowfall in winter.

DAY 06

## ISAWA – TOKYO

*Breakfast | Hotpot Lunch | Yakiniku BBQ Dinner*

- **Fruit Picking** – You can enjoy fruit picking of your favourite fruit depending on the season.
- **Mount Fuji** – Ascend Japan’s most magnificent mountain. Be Captivated by the beautiful scenery surrounding Mt Fuji. **(Mount Fuji’s 5th level will be subject to weather conditions)**
- **Odaiba Park** – Is on the edge of Tokyo Bay and provides excellent views where you can take photos of the Rainbow Bridge, Tokyo Tower and The Statue of Liberty.
- *\*Note: Bonus during 14 Apr to Mid-May departure will enjoy Fuji Shibazakura festival (seasonal) to see different coloured flowers.*

DAY 07

## TOKYO – MINAMOBOSO – NARITA

*Breakfast | Japanese Set Lunch*

- **Toyosu Market** – One of the super famous delightful gourmet town.
- **Umihotaru Parking Area** – A futuristic five-story rest stop on a man-made island, it connects to the Tokyo Wan Aqua-Line, marking the transition from a 9.6 km underwater tunnel to a 4.4 km bridge and offering impressive sightseeing views.
- **Katsuura Marine Park (Include Admission Fees)** – Is a famous coastal attraction in Japan featuring a 24-meter underwater observatory that extends below the sea surface, allowing visitors to view wild marine life in its natural through underwater windows.
- **Shimizu Mountain Stream Park** – Scenic Kameiwa Cave and Nomizo Waterfall, which produce a heart-shaped light streaming in from the river-circling cave reflects off the water’s surface, drawing a heart shape. It is unique in that the scenery changes depending on the season.
- **Mitsui Outlet Park** – You can get a wide range of discounted branded merchandise at affordable prices.

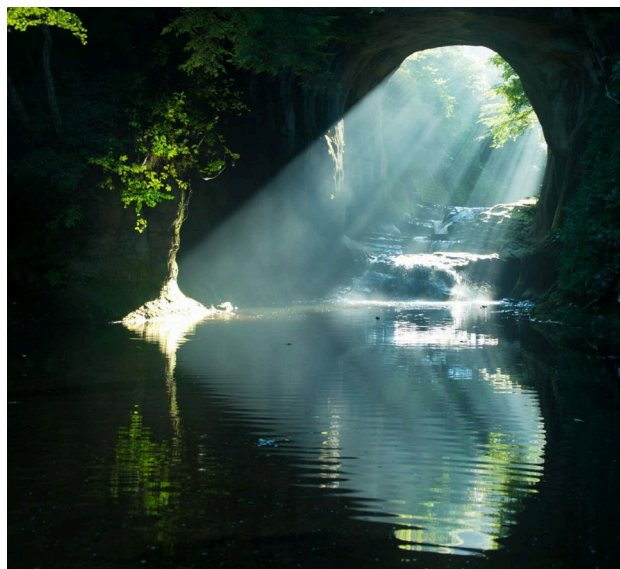

## 第一天

### 新加坡 > 名古屋/大阪

- 在新加坡樟宜机场集合，飞往“日出之国” - 日本。

## 第二天

### 名古屋/大阪 - 高山

机上用餐 | 日式套餐午餐 | 酒店晚餐

- 抵达后，由我们当地的导游热情接待。
- **犬山城** - 建于16世纪，是当时数以万计的城堡之一。这座城堡已被指定为国宝的12座城堡之一。
- **飞騨高山** - 是位于山腰的小镇，拥有古老的木屋、工艺品店和酿酒厂，保留着旧时代的魅力。常被称为三町高山老街，是通往日本阿尔卑斯山的门户。

## 第三天

### 高山 - 安曇野

早餐 | 日式陶板烧午餐 | 酒店晚餐

- **上高地** - 日本阿尔卑斯山的明珠，风景优美。1500米高的盆地，有美丽的梓河和著名的河童桥。
- **奥飞騨熊牧场** - 是一个可以近距离观赏熊的地方。牧场以亚洲黑熊为主，有包括棕熊在内的100多只熊。
- **\*注意：如果奥飞騨熊牧场没开放的情况下，行程将由川口索道取代。**

## 第四天

### 安曇野 - 立山 - 金泽

早餐 | 立山套餐午餐 | 怀石料理套餐晚餐

- 无限乐趣的一日等待着您 - 从扇泽到富山地方铁道的立山车站，全长约37.2公里。有日本阿尔卑斯山之称立山黑部峡谷。由于立山国家公园受到日本环境局列为“自然保护区”，只有国家公园内的交通工具才能使用。在这儿您将体验6种不同的交通工具登立山国家公园赏美景。

## 第五天

### 金泽 - 白川乡 - 石泽

早餐 | 日式石锅套餐午餐 | 酒店晚餐

- **兼六园（含门票）** - 日本三大名园之首的是和式庭园的典范。名为兼六，因园中兼具有“宏大、幽邃、人力、苍古、水泉、眺望”等六大优点而著名。
- **白川乡荻町合掌村** - 这个由113栋建筑组成的宁静山村于1995年被联合国教科文组织列为世界遗产。它的建筑设计被称为“合掌造”，并以60°的陡峭角度倾斜，以防止冬季大雪。

## 第六天

### 石泽 - 东京

早餐 | 涮涮锅午餐 | 日式烤肉晚餐

- **水果采摘** - 可以根据季节享受采摘您最喜欢的水果的乐趣。
- **富士山** - 登上日本最壮丽的山峰，欣赏富士山周围的美丽风景。（游富士山第五站，视天气情况而定）
- **台场公园** - 位于东京湾的边缘，享有绝佳的景色，您可以在这里拍摄彩虹桥、东京塔和自由女神像。
- **\*注意：4月14日至5月15日出发的奖励将享受富士芝樱祭（依据季节安排），以欣赏不同颜色的花朵。**

## 第七天

### 东京 - 南房总 - 成田

早餐 | 日式套餐午餐

- **丰洲市场** - 这是超级有名的美食宜人镇之一。
- **海萤火虫停车区** - 一座建在人工岛上的未来主义风格的五层休息站，连接着东京湾跨海高速公路。
- **胜浦海中公园（含门票）** - 日本著名的海岸观光景点之一。其特色是一个约24米深的海中展望塔，建筑部分延伸至海面以下，游客可以通过海底观景窗，在海洋生物的自然栖息环境中近距离观赏各种野生海洋生物。
- **清水溪流公园** - 位于日本的龟岩洞与能美增瀑布，以其独特的自然景观而闻名。当阳光从环绕河流的洞穴中照射进来时，光线会反射在水面上，形成一个“心形”的光影。
- **三井奥特莱斯购物中心** - 在这里您可以以折扣价购买到您心仪的名牌产品。

### 羽田 / 成田 > 新加坡
