

















## DAY 01 SINGAPORE > CHRISTCHURCH

Meals on Board

· Your vacation begins with a pleasant flight to Christchurch, the garden city of New Zealand.

## DAY 02 **CHRISTCHURCH**

- · Upon arrival of Garden City, Christchurch, we will let you indulge in some of the city's popular art, history and cultural hotshots which covering Cardboard Cathedral, Canterbury Arts Centre, Avon River, and Botanical Gardens.
- You also can choose to jump on the Heritage Tram, punting on the Avon River, sample the local produces at Riverside Market, exploring boutique shops in the Heart of the city along Cashel, High, Colombo Streets. (own expenses)

## CHRISTCHURCH - FOX GLACIER/FRANZ JOSEF **GLACIER**

Breakfast | Dinner

- · Enjoy the journey on spectacular alpine scenery of the snow-capped mountains, gorges, and river valleys as we journey through **Arthur Pass**, New Zealand's highest alpine pass, across to Hokitika, with its frontier town feel.
- Visit a glassblowing & greenstone factory and marvel at the creations of skilful glassblowers and the manufacturing & carving of jade from the West Coast of New Zealand.
- As you arrive in Westland National Park with its glistening white glaciers.
- The Franz Josef and Fox glaciers are relics of the last ice age. Easy walk to the scenic lookout where you can see magnificent glacier from a distance.
- You can either take the helicopters or scenic flights with snow landing to view the vistas of Mt. Cook and southern Alps. (own expenses)

## DAY 04 FOX GLACIER/WEST COAST - WANAKA -QUEENSTOWN

Breakfast | Dinner

- Travel through **Haast Pass** towards Queenstown. Formed by massive glaciers over 10,000 years ago, Lakes Wanaka and Hawea lay side by side, presenting an incomparable alpine
- · Arrowtown is surrounded by The Remarkable Mountain range, making it a perfect stop to enjoy the view and explore this beautiful town.
- Stop over at a Mrs. Jones Fruit Orchard in Cromwell to shop some local fruits.
- Continue to **Queenstown**, a town nestled by **Lake Wakatipu**. \*Depending on circumstances, overnight accommodation may be outside of Queenstown.

## **DAY 05 QUEENSTOWN - MILFORD SOUND - QUEENSTOWN**

Breakfast | Lunch on Cruise

- Today, proceed to **Milford Sound** via photo stops at **Eglinton** Valley, Mirror Lake, and Monkey Creeks.
- Experience a daylight tour to Milford Sound for amazing views of the fiord and its wildlife. A Milford Sound cruise is an adventure you don't want to miss. The 2-hour cruise takes in the best of Milford Sound and beyond, sailing out into the breath-taking Tasman Sea. Along the journey, we will see Milford Sound's scenic highlights, such as Lady Bowen Falls (dropping 160 meters down to the sea), Sinbad Gully (a classic example of a hanging valley). Snow-capped Mount Pembroke, and the awe-inspiring Mitre Peak itself, towering 1692 meters above sea level.

#### **DAY 06**

## **QUEENSTOWN - FREE DAY**

#### **Breakfast**

- Queenstown New Zealand adventure capital is a place for non-stop action. You may take the chance to settle with more relax and slow-paced activities like wandering in the town to shop for local souvenirs or relax at the local bars or cafes or queue up for the world famous Fergburger.
- Stop along by the Lake Wakatipu, where you may go for an optional jetboating adventure or TSS Earns law Cruise and Walter Peak Farm with lunch at your own expenses.

### **DAY 07**

## QUEENSTOWN - MT. COOK NATIONAL PARK - LAKE TEKAPO

#### Breakfast | Dinner

- Visit the world's first-ever bungy jumping at the Kawarau Bridge Bungy lookout.
- Proceed to Mt. Cook National Park region. En route, stop by Mt Cook Lookout at Lake Pukaki, where Mt Cook, New Zealand's highest mountain, stands. If weather permits, take an optional helicopter ride up to Tasman Glacier. (own expenses)
- Thereafter, enjoy a relaxing soak at Tekapo Springs, surrounded by mountains and the breath-taking Lake Tekapo. \*Depending on the circumstances, overnight accommodation may be outside of Lake Tekapo region.

#### DAY 08

### LAKE TEKAPO - CHRISTCHURCH

#### Breakfast | Dinner

- Visit Church of the Good Shepherd by the edge of the lovely Lake Tekapo and enjoy a scenic drive through Mackenzie Country and Burke's Pass.
- Stop at Farmers Corner, where you can shop for New Zealand premium products and souvenirs.
- Visit Alpaca Farm to interact with cute alpacas before heading back to Christchurch.

## **DAY 09**

## **CHRISTCHURCH - AUCKLAND - ROTORUA**

### Breakfast | Hangi Lunch or Dinner


- We will take a **domestic flight to Auckland** and proceed to the thermal wonderland of Rotorua in the North Island.
- City sights in Rotorua which includes Lake Rotorua, Government Gardens, and Redwood Forest. Redwood Altitude and Redwood Tree walk are on (own expenses).

- If time permits, tonight you may like to enjoy a relaxing hot mineral bath at the Polynesian Spa at your *(own expenses)*.




## **ROTORUA - AUCKLAND**


### Breakfast | Dinner
