

















DAY 01 DEPARTURE > HELSINKI

DAY 03

TROMSØ - LOFOTEN ISLANDS

- A trip to Lofoten is not complete without another photostop at the iconic Famous Sakrisøy Yellow House which is highly featured in Lonely Planet.

DAY 05

LOFOTEN ISLANDS - NARVIK

Breakfas

- In the morning, travel to Henningsvær often referred to as the "Venice of Lofoten" for its artistic charm. Surrounded by sharp mountain peaks and crystal-clear waters, this village offers breathtaking views at every turn.
- Next, we travel north, passing various fjords and scenic landscapes on our way to Narvik.
- It is an inlet of the Norwegian sea located about 200km above the Arctic Circle, yet it remains a yearlong ice-free port.

4. Together with your tour manager, you may ascend to the Hotel Bar for a view of the appearance of the Northern Lights. (for groups staying in Scandic Narvik)

DAY o6

NARVIK - ABISKO (KIRUNA) - LAPLAND

Breakfast | Dinner

- · Board the Arctic Circle Train to Abisko.
- The train line was initially opened to carry iron ore from Kiruna to Narvik and is widely used by the locals and tourists. *Departure time varies with availability and train schedule.
- Overnight in Lapland.
- 5. Tonight, we will hunt the Northern Lights with a walk together with your tour manager.

DAY 07

LAPLAND - REINDEER FARM - LAPLAND

- Our wonderful Sami guide will teach you about all the characteristics of their reindeer.
- · Hands on experience to feed the reindeer.

DAY 08

LAPLAND - SANTA CLAUS VILLAGE - WINTER HORSE SLEDGING - MOUNTAIN TOP GLASS CABIN

7. Tonight, with minimal light pollution above the mountain, you will have a high chance of catching the Northern Lights on your own.

DAY 09

LAPLAND - RANUA WILDLIFE - GLASS IGLOO

- Excursion to the Ranua Wildlife Park (World's Northern Most Zoo) which consist of approximately 50 wild animal species and 200 individuals. You will have the chance to be in close contact with the various Nordic and Arctic animals like bears, reindeers, wolves, lynxes, moose, birds, and Finland polar bear.
- A ranger will guide you and explain to you with in-depth knowledge of the different Arctic animals.






LAPLAND - HUSKY DOG FARM > HELSINKI


Breakfast | Dinner

 Husky Dog Farm (2hrs Activity)- Meeting the dogs and having a closer look at them. The guide tells you about their














- life habits and particular features of the husky dogs. The culmination of the tour is a ride on a dog sledge on wheels

REMARKS

- The sequence of the itinerary may change due to the availability of glass igloos, domestic flight schedules, or weather conditions.
- Northern Lights are a natural phenomenon, and we cannot guarantee their appearance due to weather conditions.
- 3. The estimated 2-hour time at the Husky Farm is only an estimate and may vary.
- Lapland Hotels do not have a star rating. However, equivalent accommodations will be provided.
- 5. Weather conditions in Lapland are highly unpredictable, and roads and attractions may close with little notice. In such cases, we will adjust the itinerary and proceed with alternative routes based on the best possible situation. In the event of adverse weather conditions, the Driver and Tour Manager will make the final decision on whether to proceed with the day's program or cancel it.
- During peak seasons, the Tour Manager may not fly with the group, but a check-in staff member will be allocated. The Tour Manager will meet the group upon arrival.
- Some accommodations may not have twin or double room options.
- 8. Passengers may opt to use a bus for a longer Northern Lights hunting excursion, with prior agreement from the entire group. This must be confirmed at least 3 days in advance, and costs will be shared equally among group members.
- 9. The Glass Igloo / Glass Resort image is for illustration purposes only.
- 10. Upgrades to Glass Igloo / Glass Resort are subject to availability. Please check with us for confirmation on your booked igloo / resort
- 11. Upgrades to Mountain Top Glass Cabins are only available for departures from September 1st, 2025 – December 10th, 2025. Outside of these dates, a hotel accommodation will be provided instead. However, not all groups departing during the period are entitled to 2 nights free upgrade. Do check with us on the availability.
- 12. Northern Lights hunting is dependent on the KP index and weather forecasts. The Tour Manager will decide whether to proceed based on these factors. As adequate rest is necessary for the Tour Manager's performance, tour manager will not wait beyond 11:00 PM.
- 13. The Arctic Circle Train may close unexpectedly due to adverse weather. There will be no replacement or refund in such cases.
- 14. We reserve the right to use a different supplier for the King Crab Safari based on the itinerary. If the safari is conducted at a different location, the experience may vary. In Kirkenes, the King Crab Safari will replace Norwegian Shrimp with Cod Fish Cake, and the King Crab will not be slaughtered in front of guests.
