

 After breakfast, free at leisure till your transfer to the airport for your flight back home. Hope you have a joyful vacation with LGE Travel!







- Passengers purchase optional excursions on their own expenditure and at their own risk; LGE will not be responsible. Therefore, travel insurance is recommended to ensure coverage.








